

WAS YOUR CAT IN A FALL?

ALERT SIGNS YOU MUST NOT IGNORE

Observing your cat after a fall can make a difference. These signs may indicate it needs veterinary attention.



01



PALE OR WHITE GUMS

May be a sign of shock.

02



RAPID OR DIFFICULT BREATHING

Can indicate an injury requiring assessment.

03



LIMPING OR DIFFICULTY WALKING

Can be related to limb injuries.

04



BLEEDING

Requires attention, especially if it doesn't stop.

05



LETHARGY OR DISORIENTATION

May indicate the cat is not well after impact.

06



ABNORMAL POSTURES

Can be a sign of pain or injury.



IF YOU NOTICE ANY CONCERNING SIGN:

Go to the veterinarian as soon as possible.



Avoid moving your cat abruptly.



If a significant injury is possible, limit its movements during transport.



IMPORTANT

Do not administer human medication on your own. Some can be toxic for cats.



After a fall, observing is also caring.
